Since the last newsletter of the OWF, the Commonwealth Championships has taken place in Limassol – Cyprus. Oceania lifters were quite successful at these Championships winning three categories in the men senior and three categories in the men junior. The winners in the seniors were Mark Spooner (New Zealand), Yukio Peter (Nauru) and Damon Kelly (Australia). Whilst in the juniors the winners were Malek Chamoun (Australia), Robert Galsworthy (Australia) and Sam Pera Jr. (Cook Islands).

COMMONWEALTH CHAMPIONSHIPS – CYPRUS

The Championships were held in the beautiful city of Limassol in Cyprus from the 3rd to 7th December.

The event was a great success and congratulations must go to the President of the Cyprus Weightlifting Federation, Mr. Damianos Hadjidamianou and his daughter Joanna for all her efforts in the organization of the event. The event was very well set up, transport and accommodation was excellent, and the social activities organized by the President every evening were unmatched.

Sixteen countries took part in the event with unfortunately a few extra missing out due to late applications for visas. It was very good to see the gold medals particularly in the men categories being shared by Cyprus, New Zealand, Nauru, South Africa, Scotland, Barbados and Australia with Cyprus winning the team event. The junior men tournament was dominated by Malaysia whilst South Africa took the majority of gold in the women categories. It is a pity that Malaysia only entered their lifters in the junior event and not the seniors as well. The best male lifter in the senior event was Yukio Peter from Nauru whilst the best female lifter was Portie Vires from South Africa.

C.W.F CONGRESS

The CWF Congress was held on the 4th December. Discussed were the following:

- The constitution was presented, to be reviewed next year and then being accepted at the 2010 Commonwealth Games in Dehli.
- The Executive Board was expanded to include six more Executive Board Members. Two members
- from Oceania were included in the board. They are **Mr. Atma Maharaj (Fiji) and**
- **Mr. Robert Kabbas (Australia)**
- Mr. Atma Maharaj (Fiji) has been appointed Chairman of the Marketing division.
- Malaysia will be the host nation for the 2009 Commonwealth Senior and Junior Championships. The date set at this stage is December 16th – 20th
- The 2011 Commonwealth Championships for Junior and Senior is still open with South Africa being very keen to host it. The decision will be made in Malaysia in December next year.
- There will be no Commonwealth Senior Championships in 2010 being the Commonwealth Games year.
