THE RETURN OF THE SAMOAN GAMES

On May 26th, the Samoa Games returned in Apia, after a number of years in hiatus. The weightlifting event was held at the High Performance Centre. The centre has over 25 platforms and I was very surprised to see that all platforms were in use during the training sessions. Eileen Cikamatana and Lilly Coffa also attended the Games. Spending a wonderful week in Samoa.

<u>Whi</u>lst there, the training sessions were held in the morning and also in the afternoon. The intensity of training was phenomenal. Very few lifters from the Oceania region would be able to fully cope. And I suppose this is one reason why the Samoan lifters are so far advanced. Another factor which impressed me was the number of youth lifters training. Most important, so many of the past top lifters of Samoa, in the gym coaching the next generation.





During the actual weightlifting event, in attendance some of the guests were Seiuli Paul Wallwork, past President of the OWF and the first Samoan lifter to win a medal at the Commonwealth Games back in 1974 where he won a silver medal. Also in attendance was the President of the Samoa Olympic Committee Tala Pauga and the CEO of the Samoa Olympic Committee Tuala Mathew Vaea.

Jerry Wallwork, did a fantastic job in setting up the whole event and at the same time coaching the senior members of the team. There were some excellent performances from Nevo Ioane 67kg category, John Tafi 73kg category, Manuila Raobu from Tuvalu in the 73kg cat, Ruben Katoatau from Kiribati in the 81kg category, Sanele Mao 109+kg category, Iuniarra Sipaia 87+kg category. The best lifter was none other than Don Opeloge, who established a Commonwealth Senior Clean & Jerk record with a lift of 206kg in the clean & Jerk. Countries competing were: Samoa, Kiribati, Tuvalu, Australia and Marshall Islands.

Finally I would like to thank the President Jerry Wallwork for extending a kind invitation to take part in the Samoa Games. And also for the wonderful hospitality during a week long stay in Apia.
